



Greetham Community Playarea are excited to announce that Rutland County Council have awarded the playarea a grant of £27,500. This is a significant addition to the current fund. The current playarea was originally installed 20 years ago and although small improvements have been made since then, much of the equipment has become dated and worn. With over £10,000 raised by Greetham Villagers, the additional funding from Rutland County Council will enable work to start this year to install new equipment for the under 5's area this year.
